- Take a ferry from Dublin to Holyhead
- Visit a Welsh castle
- Travel via Snowdonia to North Wales

### Day 5: North Wales | London

- Take a tour of Stratford
- Visit Shakespeare's birthplace
- Visit the gardens at Anne Hathaway's cottage
- Continue on to London

### Day 6: London

- Take a guided tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; St. Paul's Cathedral; Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled)
- Take a walking tour of London: Trafalgar Square; Covent Garden
- Enjoy a fish and chips dinner

- Enjoy a free day in London
- *Optional: Westminster Abbey*

### Day 8: London | Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris
- Take a guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral

### Day 9: Paris

- Take a walking tour of Paris
- Visit the Louvre
- *Optional: Versailles*

## Paris

Bonjour, Paris! During your sightseeing in the City of Light, get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*. Then, travel to the Notre Dame Cathedral and admire its sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.

## London

London has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. A local guide introduces you to Europe's largest city on your sightseeing tour. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. Finally, snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.

## Dublin

Experience Ireland's capital, scenically situated between Dun Laoghaire (pronounced "dun leery") and Howth Head's rocky peaks. On your sightseeing tour, you'll pass by Phoenix Park and the presidential residence. Continue to bustling O'Connell Street. Playwright Samuel Beckett and satirist Jonathan Swift studied at Trinity College, your next stop. In the Long Room of the Old Library you'll view the *Book of Kells*. Irish monks created this calligraphic manuscript over 1,000 years ago. Then, visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, whose presence honors the patron saint of Ireland. When you ride through Dublin's elegant Georgian squares, remember to ask your guide about the colorful doors!




